## Travel to Lisbon, Portugal with UMass Lowell during the Summer for an Immersive Experience

Enjoy a unique international experience in Lisbon, the largest city and capital of Portugal (member of the European Union.) Immerse yourself in this at once ancient and modern waterfront city characterized by a thrilling culture, delicious cuisine, and booming nightlife. Take advantage of the rich architectural history of Romanesque and Gothic churches, a medieval castle, and UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Revel in a diverse music scene, with the soulful melodies of Portuguese fado, varieties of Cape Verdean and Brazilian music, cutting-edge jazz, and classical music. Take strolls through the bairros of this beautiful, safe and historic city, or get around in a first-rate public transport system. There will be side-trips to picturesque towns, including Sintra, also a World Heritage Site.

Spend two weeks exploring everything Lisbon has to offer, while earning 3 college credits.

#### **Academics**

All students need to enroll in the UMass Lowell course, WLPO.3020 (course description and faculty bio in the back).
