Study Program

The content of the study program varies according to the profile of each university. Most courses are taught in English, some Hessen Short-Term Programs also offer courses taught in German

Faculty

The program faculty consists of experts in their individual fields. They come from the participating Hessen universities and their international partners.

Course Credits

Upon successful completion of the program, you will receive credits based on the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS). For each seminar/module (including the German language course), you will receive ECTS credits that often can be transferred to your home university. Thus, after studying in Germany for four weeks, not only will you have spent an exciting time in Germany, but you will also have earned credits that can contribute to your academic career.

Language Courses

In addition to the study program, Hessen:ISUs and IWUs provide the opportunity to learn German. There is no more effective way to learn German than to learn it in Germany and to be able to practice it in your daily life. German language classes are offered at varying levels of competency to cater to those who have never learnt German and to those who want to improve their language skills.

Accommodation

Depending on the particular program, you will be hosted in dormitories, shared apartments, or hotels, or placed with host families that have been carefully selected by the program team.
