The University:

The University of Minho, founded in 1973, changed the landscape of higher education in Portugal. Located in the Minho region, known for its economic activity and the youth of its population, the university is playing a role in the development of the region. With over 19,000 students, 1,300 professors and 600 employees, UM is one of the largest Portuguese universities. As of 2013, the University of Minho appears on the ranking of Times Higher Education as one of the 100 best universities of the world under the age of 50.

WHY STUDY IN PORTUGAL?

HOUSING

Whenever possible, students will stay at University Residences, but there is also, in some cases, the possibility of staying in student apartments or family houses. If the host university does not provide permanent housing (for example, when there are no University Residences), students should make a reservation for temporary accommodation and you will have to seek permanent accommodation on arrival, usually with the help of the host university, student associations and other associated entities (in these cases it is advisable to arrive early before the start of the semester). Double and single rooms are available.
