## **CZECH TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY**

#### The University:

Renowned as one of the oldest technical institutes and the oldest non-military technical university in Europe, the Czech Technical University (CTU) in Prague was founded in 1707. Since then, the university has grown by leaps and bounds, adding 105 degree programs and 419 fields of study. Today, CTU is ranked 150 worldwide in Engineering and Technology and 151-200 in Computer Engineering in QS University Ranking. Each year about 24,000 students attend CTU.

### WHY STUDY IN THE CZECH REPUBLIC?

The Czech Republic is a landlocked country in Central Europe. Its unique location at the crossroads between eastern and western Europe allows easy travel around the continent. ### HOUSING

About 8,000 local and international students are accommodated each year in CTU dormitories. Every new student is offered a bed. University accommodation normally means a shared rooms, a two-bed rooms, in some cases even a three-bed room. The university accommodation is inexpensive and conveniently located, with unlimited high-speed internet access. If you wish to live on your own and there is no single room available, there is an option of getting a double room in a university dormitory for 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> times the price for a bed in a double room.
